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Dress-A-Bear[™]

Dress-A-Bear[™] (SM# – 0711), distributed through Super Duper Publications, is a simple to play board game for young children that can easily be used with the Gateway[®] page sets. It can be used to help children learn the names of four (4) articles of clothing, and form simple sentences as they move around the game board dressing their bear. The game is intended for preschool through early elementary aged students. Complete directions to play the game are included on the game box.

Activity Description: This "Dress-Up" core vocabulary set contains words that can be used to select clothing to dress the bear as the child moves around the game board. The child can select the item by indicating its color in addition to naming the item.
