Pronoun Parade Fun Deck[®]

Pronoun Parade Fun Deck[™] is a card game, produced and distributed through Super Duper Publications (FD# - 21) - www.superduperinc.com. It is designed to teach the correct use of the pronouns he, she and they. The card deck contains 54 cards with each card of the pair depicting the same subject and object. The chart below suggests a modification to one card set so that all of the 54 cards can be used for Gateway 40 and 60. Since the game uses proper names for the characters depicted on the card, it is suggested is that “man”, “lady”, “boy” or “girl” be substituted for them when using any of the Gateway page sets. In addition to the suggested games provided with the *Pronoun Parade Fun Deck* instructions, the stimulus cards can also be used as fun materials while encouraging children use their Gateway core words to describe “what else” they see in the pictures.



The *Pronoun Parade Fun Deck*[™] is an appropriate therapy tool for children using Gateway 40 and Gateway 60 from Pre-K to 5th grade. It comes with suggested activities for how the cards can be used. For Gateway users who are included within regular education programs, the *Pronoun Parade Fun Deck* is a wonderful resource to integrate these children with peers who may be working on the same expressive language goals.

Gateway[®] Intervention Goals:

- Vocabulary: Acquisition** –Pronouns he, she, they; who, has, is, are, selected verbs,
- Expressive Language: Syntax & Morphology** - Formation of questions using “who”; S-V-O; Use of Pres. Progressive Verb Tense w/ articles

Suggested AAC Intervention Strategies: **Modeling** **Expansion** **Aided Language Stimulation**
